3. Chapter IV Section 3 - Consider removal or abolishment of Board of Tax Review.
4. Chapter IV Section 4 - Consider the continued need for Town Constables.
5. Chapter V Section 3 - Consider the continued need for a Board of Selectman.
6. Chapter VIII Section 3 - Consider the legality / effectiveness of the Building Inspector being the Zoning Enforcement Officer.
7. Chapter X Section 4 - Consider a process of the hiring the Fire Marshal by the Fire Chief.
8. Chapter XI Section 3 – Consider the need for the Department of Welfare. ✓
9. Chapter XIV Section 2 – Consider expanding the Public Utilities Committee beyond 3 members.
10. Chapter XIV Section 13 – Consider the Town Council’s veto power of an action of the PUC to end 15 days after notice to Town Council.
11. Consider integrating electronic publication into the Charter where appropriate.
