Meeting commenced at 7:18 PM.

The minutes of the meeting on Jan 23, 2012 were updated and approved. Commission members received letters from Mayor Dickinson saying the municipal building energy audits remain to be done for 2 departments and should be completed soon. Commission resolved to follow up with the mayor in March as to the status of those final audits.

John Lynch updated the commission on the status of the school roof replacement project. The committee met on Feb 15 with Attorney Janice Small to determine bid process. The solar portion of the project will be bid as a separate project just as all the roofs are single projects.

The commission discussed upcoming public events to be held at the library on April 11 and April 26<sup>th</sup>. April 11 at 6:30 will be a showing of the film Earth: The Operators Manual with a discussion to follow moderated by Tory Searcy.

And the description used to request exhibitor will be:

The event will feature exhibits from several organizations and a speaker from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. The commission will contact organizations to line up displays and meet with library staff to finalize plans soon.
