Minutes

The Commission was called to order at 7:05 PM.

The draft minutes of the Feb 24 meeting were approved unanimously.

Members who attended the PUC meeting on March 15 reported that they are diligently looking for funding sources and enthusiastic about the School Energy Conservation project.

Roger Smith from the West Hartford Energy Commission joined us to talk about some of the projects that West Hartford have undertaken. After early success qualifying for solar systems for town buildings they decided to develop an energy use reduction plan for the town. This plan set targets and goals. The plan was reviewed and approved by town officials and they are now working with the town on strategies for reaching these goals.

Roger also discussed several proposed State bills that would provide funding options for solar and energy efficiency projects (HB 5362, HB 5465).

Mary planned on attending the CMEEC meeting on March 25 at 9:00 AM to request that they setup municipal lease options for energy projects.

Ros reported that the water department is ready to purchase their first hybrid, they are deciding which of the 3 options to buy. They are also applying for a grant to buy a second hybrid.
