Meeting commenced at 7:14 PM.

The minutes of the meeting on April 23 were approved.

John provided an update from the School Roof Committee. 2 of the 4 solar panel installation proposed were approved by the Town Council.

Construction is scheduled to start this summer.

The commission discussed the Energy Conservation and Alternative Energy Sources program held on April 26th at the Wallingford Library. Attendance was modest but the event went well. Sharon Emmons gave an excellent presentation on the Wallingford Electric Division's effort to encourage energy efficiency. The commission discussed possibly planning another event for the fall with better publicity and involving other local social groups.

The commission also reviewed and discussed the report provided by Mayor Dickinson containing the results and recommendations for the municipal building energy audits performed by CMEEC. The general feeling was that the report was an excellent step forward and the commission should determine how to best encourage timely implementation of the recommendations. John will draft a response to the mayor thanking him for providing the report.

Mary informed the commission that there is a CMEEC meeting in Wallingford on June 26th at 10:00 AM to discuss providing energy efficiency assistance programs similar to CL&P and UI.

Finally the commission spoke about finishing the document detailing the actions and efforts taken since the commission was created. It was also suggested that we review some previous projects and determine if further action should be taken.
