Meeting commenced at 7:18 PM. The minutes from meeting on 5/23/2011 were approved.

Sharon spoke to Ric Hendershot about PUC energy conservation efforts and was updated on status of energy audits for town buildings. The walkthroughs have not been scheduled because they are working on gathering the information for CMEEC to submit for benchmarking. Process is proceeding similar to the school energy conservation program. Ric also informed her that 1949 households have taken advantage of energy audit offer, 51 has improved insulation based on the audit, and 260 customers have signed up for the Clean Energy Option from Wallingford Electric Division. They also had distributed more than 200,000 Compact Fluorescent light bulbs and are subsidizing purchasing these bulbs through local home improvement stores.

John gave an update on the school roof committee. Because they are working on a tight schedule and within state guidelines it may be difficult to incorporate large changes but he will advocate for considering energy costs in decisions.

Mary will provide letterhead for commission communication.

Chris will provide analysis of programs we can take advantage of in the latest energy bill passed by CT legislature(PACE, Residential Solar, performance contracts)

We discussed visiting similar groups in other town for information sharing.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:30.
