Meeting commenced at 7:18 PM. The minutes from the meeting on 6/29/2011 were approved.

John provided update on school roof committee. They had a meeting on July 7th at which John suggested adding energy conservation measures to the roof design and the idea was well received. Sal Menzo is also supportive. They are scheduled to receive architect proposals soon and will review them for ranking. John has contacted Dept of Energy and Environmental Protection for information on energy saving roof options but has not received a response. Mary also suggested contacting the Institute for Sustainable Energy. Sharon will contact DEEP and ISE for more information. Bill will draft a letter to the roof committee and town council recommending that all energy saving options be considered.

Mary will be sending the information on the energy saving pump upgrades that Trumbull implemented to the Wallingford Water Dept. and a letter asking if they have any scheduled maintenance or replacement soon.

Mary will also finish the draft report on our activities to date and send to the commission.

Sharon will be following up with Rick Hendershot on the status of benchmarking data for energy audits of town buildings

Councilor Testa inquired about the cost of performance audits and other WECC priorities.
