Commision Approved minutes from July 26th meeting. Ben reported that Sal Menzo had sent a draf t RFP for hiring energy manager to RickHendershot & Mike Cassella to review for edits so it could be submitted to Sal Ammodio by next week (Aug 30- Sept 5).

Commision reviewed the electric used data collated by Bill Pursell to decide if we should organize it for audit by town department or for entire town. It was decided that data and buildings should be reviewed by professional auditor. Chris Smith was going to further organize the data by town department. Also based on this data Ben Martin was going to contact some renewable energy companies about installing systems at town sport facilities. Sharon Mooney was going to call to other town to see if they had received grants for sewer/water upgrades.

John Lynch contacted George Adair at PUC to initiate dialog about working together on energy projects. Ben will contact Mayor's office about gas & oil usage data as they may have collected this information in recent years. Roz Page will contact Water & Sewer Department to see if they have any conservation programs in the works.

Mary Mushinsky suggested producing semi-annual report to provide town with progress of conservation effort and the group agreed. The group also discussed contacting commission members who had not attended meetings recently if they would like to continue to serve.
