Meeting called to order at 7:21. The meeting minutes for September 30, 2013 were edited and approved.

Commission discussed follow up items from the September meeting. The November PUC meeting was the 19th so Mary made a motion for Ben to request some time at their next meeting to discuss 3 items: creating an improved clean energy rate, implementing a program to encourage solar installations in Wallingford, and request a liason from the Electric Division to the WECC. The motion was approved. Mary will send information to the the mayor's office on the programs to fund electric vehicle charging stations.

The commission discussed recruitment of new members. Mary will provide the name of a faculty member at the Choate environmental school for Ben to contact. Sharon will call Mike Brodinsky to find out if Bill should attend the remaining school roof committee meetings in place of John Lynch, and if any the committee members would be interested in joining the Energy Conservation Commission. Bill will contact the science teachers in the school system to see if they would be interested in joining the commission.

There was no response from the mayor's office regarding how the municipal building audits will be implemented by the town departments. The commission decided to review the audits and discuss a list of questions and recommendations to department heads at the next meeting.

The next two meetings are scheduled for Dec 23, 2013 and Jan 27, 2014.
