Meeting Commenced at 7:16 PM

The commission discussed the WECC Activity Report , suggesting a few changes. Once approved by all members we will share with George Adair, Don Roe, Rick Hendershot, and Mayor Dickinson and request their input.

Mary spoke with Mike Cassella and was told that the latest energy audits of municipal buildings are completed. The documents will be shared with the commission as soon as they are available.

The commission discussed ways to encourage implementation of the energy saving measures reported in this audit including developing a presentation for the town council, asking Citizen Mike to highlight the report, and bringing in representatives from towns that have implemented energy saving measures. Ben will develop outline of presentation to fill data into later.

Sharon informed the commission that NXEGEN will be meeting with the school administration about next steps to continue lower energy use. She will continue to communicate with Sal Menzo and NXEGEN for dates and details of the next meeting.

John informed the commission that the School Roof Committee still plans to install 2 solar systems on the school roofs next summer.

Mary informed the commission that we could host the Energy Savings Panel at the Senior Center. Mary is lining up speakers from different fuel sources to talk about how to save energy: Oil, Natural Gas, CEFIA(clean energy funding), and Wallingford Electric Division. Panel date is dependent on the Senior Center, possibly in February. The commission discussed inviting town officials, social workers, veterans officer, Spanish Center of Wallingford and putting some notices up in the library and other town businesses.

The commission decided that the meetings for 2013 would be held on the 4th Monday of every month.
