Minutes

Meeting commenced at 7:10

The commission discussed the proposed solar project at Meriden Markham Airport. The commission resolved to contact the Zoning Board of Appeals to express our support and find out where the project stands. Bill will draft a letter to send.

The commission approved a draft letter written by Matt to encourage the town to purchase electric cars and charging stations. He only needs the logo to send to Mayor Dickinson. The commission also resolved to find out if there are any charging stations on municipal properties in Wallingford. Mary announced that the manager she had been working with at Stop & Shop moved to another store and she would have to work with the new manger on installing a charging station there.

Bill presented a spreadsheet showing monthly energy use data from the Wallingford school system. This data is sent monthly and Bill will share it with the other commissioners. Bill will also check on the status of the kiosk monitors to track energy use and production of the solar panels.

The commission discussed replying to the letter received in the fall of 2014 regarding actions taken based on municipal building audits and contacting the department heads to ask if they are putting conservation upgrades in their budgets.

Matt asked about assembling documentation to share with Wallingford citizens on saving energy. He will work on a draft brochure.
