The Jan 23, 2013 minutes were approved.

The Feb 25, 2013 minutes were approved.

John informed the commission that the School Roof Committee plans were approved and the bids are out. Supporting brackets for the solar arrays need to be installed before summer so the systems can be installed with the roof.

Mary received the municipal building audit reports from Mike Cassella and provided them to Bill for analysis and organization. Bill reported that there seem to be some town buildings missing and the recommended measures do not achieve large reductions. Bill will follow up with authors to get more information.

The commission discussed revising the WECC goals. It was suggested that we focus on reducing the energy demand for people on fuel assistance and Wallingford residents living in apartments. Several ideas were discussed such as talking to owners of apartment buildings about energy saving measures, setting a goal for the number of units audited(EX: 85%), incorporating energy efficiency into building codes, and creating a brochure of energy efficiency improvement requirements.
