Meeting commenced at 7:20 PM. Minutes from March 26, 2013 were approved. Bill updated the commission on correspondence with Josh Zaentz from Echo, the company that conducted the municipal building energy audits. The reports highlighted cost and savings opportunities for 20 buildings but seemed incomplete and not very thorough. The commission discussed inquiries to address these concerns:

- Is an Energy Use Profile available for each building?
- Who is responsible for implementation?
- What were the specifications of the job?
- What does Energy Star rating mean?

Ben stated he would find the previous building audit report and send it for comparison.

John updated the commission on the status of the solar panels on the school roof. The installers want to install mounting brackets as soon as possible. The construction of roofs is planned to start as school ends.
