The meeting commenced at 7:10 PM

The minutes from the meeting of 11/28/2011 were approved.

John gave us an update on the school roof building committee. Design work is 95% finished and they expect to go to the council for approval in January.

The commission approved a proposed outline for a potential meeting with Mayor Dickinson. Sharon will contact his office to request a meeting. Bill will check with Mary to get the status of the commission's progress report. Ben will follow up with NXEGEN for up to date energy savings of the school project. Troy provided documentation on several solar projects around the state.

The commission discussed plans for an Earth Day event in 2012. The commission approved the idea of pursuing a speaker in the library common room. Other ideas included energy producing exercise bikes, inviting the PUC, inviting Choate to talk about Kohler environmental center and a lighting demand display. The option of showing a film on a separate night was also discussed. The date will depend on speaker availability.

Sharon and John reported on the meeting of New Haven county regional energy teams. 25 – 30 people from different towns attended and most were working on residential buildings instead of municipal. They learned that towns that use CL&P and UI may be required to report municipal building electricity usage.

Commission resolved to hold meetings on the 4th Monday of each month at 7:00 in 2012.
