The Town of Wallingford offers the services listed below to residents. **All services require an initial screening for financial eligibility. All information provided is CONFIDENTIAL.**

Please call Youth and Social Services at 203-294-2175 for Financial Screening Appointment for the following services:

1. Well Child Clinic: Provides childhood vaccinations, TB screenings, developmental screenings, Birth -18 yrs of age
2. School physicals (entrance and sports) Birth – 18 yrs.

Individual appointments are scheduled weekly for above services AFTER initial Financial screening.

Monthly Childhood Dental Clinics including exam, cleanings and sealants for children ages 2-18 or high school completion. Appointment required: 203-269-1475

Mental Health Services, Counseling and Support Groups. No age restriction

Adult immunizations (Flu, Pneumonia, Hep B and TB screening).
