

## **ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION**

**Election day registration allows eligible persons who meet all qualifications, are a resident of this town, have a photo I.D. with their current address on it, or other stringent I.D. requirements, who missed the last registration day (Nov. 1, 2016), to come to the Town Clerk's office to register and vote. They complete a new registration form as well as an application form for the ballot. A search of the state system must be made before allowing you to fill in the application for a EDR ballot. If you are found still registered in another town, we must call that town, provide your information and have them call to the applicable poll and have a search done to determine if you may have already voted in person or by absentee. Anyone that has, and attempts to vote again in this town, will be charged with an election felony and prosecuted. If you are not on the State system you will be allowed to fill out the application for a ballot, given one, allowed to vote and seal it in a special envelope. This can be done between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8 P.M. Anyone not completing the applications by 8 P.M. will not be allowed to vote, even if you are in line to execute this process before 8 P.M. Understand that this is a lengthy process and the office is very busy with multiple phone lines, answering questions by voters, poll workers from 9 polls, inquiries from other towns, and now outgoing inquiries to our polls from other towns. We will make every effort to assist you in a timely manner, but the phones must be answered as our first priority. Be prepared for a slow process and be patient; we will get to you as soon as possible.**

**Be aware also that if you turned 18 between 11/1/16 and 11/8/16, became a citizen (same time frame) or just moved into town (same time frame) and have documentation that proves that, you may come into the Registrar's office on Monday 11/7/16 by 12 noon and you can register to vote. EDR may only be done on election day.**
